As we approach the end of the project, we're excited to share the latest developments with you!

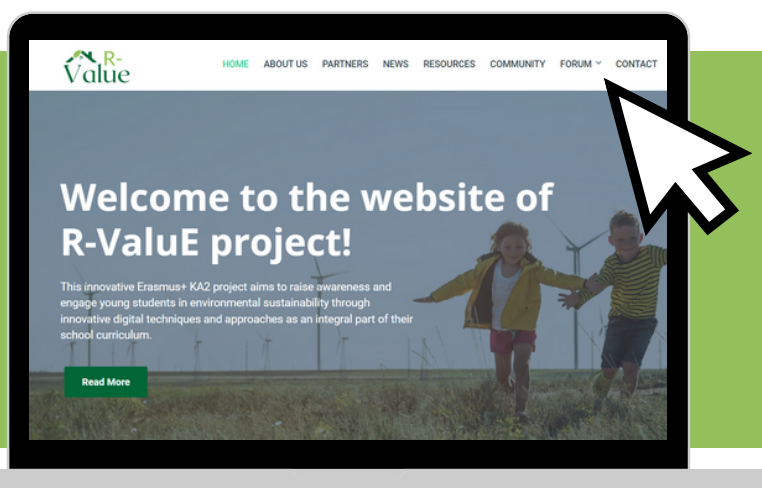
Our final transnational partner meeting took place in České Budějovice, Czech Republic, where we came together to put the finishing touches on the project and its key outputs.

We are proud to announce the completion of the *Teacher's Handbook*, now available on our project website in 7 different languages. This digital guide is an invaluable resource for teachers, providing practical tips, inspiration, and activities to integrate sustainability into their curriculum. The handbook is divided into six comprehensive modules, each focused on a crucial aspect of sustainability:



- **What is Sustainability?** – Introducing students to the core concept of sustainability and its importance in daily life
- **Circular Economy Thinking Practices** – Encouraging students to think about ways to reduce waste and reimagine resource use through circular economy principles
- **Waste Management** – Offering practical activities that teach students how to manage waste responsibly and adopt sustainable habits
- **Eco-Conscious Lifestyle** – Focusing on the small yet impactful changes students can make in their everyday lives to live more sustainably
- **Digital Tools for Education** – Equipping students with the skills and knowledge to use digital tools to enhance learning about sustainability
- **Digital Stories for Sustainability** – Using digital storytelling as a method to help students express their ideas and knowledge about sustainability creatively

Additionally, the Practice Green Toolkit has also been finalised and is available on our project website in 7 different languages. This digital resource is designed for elementary school students and offers a range of engaging, practical activities aimed at deepening their understanding of sustainability and promoting circular behaviours.
